

What To Bring To Camp 2024

STUFF YOU NEED

Please put your child's name on everything they bring.

- ♦ Bible
- Towels for pool and personal use (Towels and washcloths are <u>not</u> provided by Trinity Pines.)
- Pen or pencil for taking notes (Notebooks will be provided for you.)
- ♦ Clothes:

Appropriate swimsuit - (Girls: a dark shirt must be worn over a 2-piece bathing suit.)

Shoes suitable for outdoor activities
(Bring at least 2 pairs. If it rains, it will be muddy. Closed-toed tennis shoes must be worn during morning rec and at the adventure course.)
Shorts are permitted at all services.
NOTE: Some activities can get messy so bring appropriate clothes and shoes.

- ♦ Insect repellent
- ♦ Sunscreen
- ◆ Backpack
- Toiletries: toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, conditioner, etc.
- Medications (Parents, only send if necessary—must be accompanied by medication form and checked in with church leader.)
- ♦ Wide mouth water bottle

- Expensive personal belongings (jewelry, expensive cameras, etc.)

- Skateboards, roller blades, roller shoes or scooters
- Over the counter medication (camp nurse has Tylenol, ibuprofen etc.)
- Anything else that should not be at camp
